

# La Habra Dance Program

## Levels offered

**Dance Production:** This is our performance group and the highest level of dance offered. It requires dance experience and an audition to enroll. We perform two times a year for our fall and spring dance shows and occasional other performances, such as pep rallies and Homecoming Half-Time. Students in this class are eligible to receive a letter and a chord at graduation if all requirements are met. This class takes place during 6<sup>th</sup> period. Cheerleaders that make Dance Production will be enrolled in Dance Production but may do both. Students must be able to enroll in the 6<sup>th</sup> period class.

**Advanced Dance:** Advanced dance requires both experience and an audition to be enrolled in this class. Dancers enrolled in this class are not required to perform, but will have the opportunity to perform in our two dance shows mentioned above. Students must be able to enroll in the 5<sup>th</sup> period class.

**Intermediate Dance:** Enrollment at this level requires either placement at audition or successful completion of one year of dance at La Habra High School.

**Dance:** No audition needed. This is an introduction to dance class. It will cover a variety of dance styles and focus on dance technique.

The expenses associated with performing are very minimal and are not a requirement for participating in the Dance Program. Program directors work very hard on scheduling to make it possible for students to be in multiple programs at the same time, such as Dance, Cheer, Band, Choir and Theater.
